







2019 Year in Review

DURSA Amendment



Why was the DURSA amended?

- The Coordinating Committee (CC) explored the requirements for the eHealth Exchange to become a Carequality Implementer
- A policy review determined that a DURSA Amendment is necessary to pursue becoming and Carequality Implementer
- Adjustments were necessary to align our network with the current market (i.e. expanded Permitted Purposes to support new use cases) given that the DURSA hasn't been changed in 8+ years
 - Allow Value-Based Care Organizations to join
 - Allow individuals to access health info & direct where info can be sent
 - etc
- Changes to the DURSA must be accomplished in accordance with the DURSA Amendment Process detailed in OPP #8.

Changes cover the following DURSA Provisions

- Definition of Participant
- Permitted Purposes
- Coordinating Committee
- Minimum Participation Requirements
- Duties When Submitting a Message
- Auditing and Monitoring
- Privacy and Security
- Data Breach Notification
- Third Party Technology
- Liability

DURSA Amendment Steps & Timeline

- August 13, 2019: Coordinating Committee approved
- August 26, 2019: Coordinating Committee distributed official notice
 Participants had fifteen (15) calendar days to request 2/1/2020 effective date be postponed based on unforeseen complications or other good cause. No requests we received.
- September 2019: Provided, recorded, and published 4 web meetings and other materials provided to educate Participants regarding DURSA changes
- October 1, 2019 through November 30, 2019: Participants vote to amend the DURSA



December 1, 2019 through January 31, 2020: All Participants must sign the amendment to the DURSA prior to the effective date of the amendment or terminate their participation (required by the DURSA and Operating Policy & Procedure #3)







Carequality Connectivity



Carequality

- 1. Notification Coming Early January 2020
 - a. Ability to opt-out for any reason through 3/31/2020
 - b. eHealth Exchange's Carequality fee
 - c. Ability to begin transacting in Production as early as 2/1/2020 (4/1/2020 for most Participants)
 - d. Pilot (non-Production) activities can continue past 1/31/2020
- 2. NC HealthConnex & Quality Health Networks Opting-Out
- 3. Epic Participants, CommonSpirit, HCA Mission, Santa Cruz HIO, CRISP, Konza, Manifest Medex, MiHIN, & Womba might want to opt-out since already connected to Carequality
