Multiple Document Retrieve

- Context:
 - The number of documents being retrieved has undocumented hard limits and expectations, esp.
 on the responder side
 - Currently this issue seems localized to eHx Hub Carequality networks bridge transactions
- Proposed solution approach:
 - Gather more information and inform Carequality bridge participants
 - Staff will review QD/RD requests from all Bridge Participants. Establish RD request behaviors
 - Announce test results to all Bridge Participants

Multiple Document Retrieve (Cont.)

- Ask impacted Bridge Subscribers, to determine if their vendor:
 - Limit requests to a single document
 - Change the gateway with configuration only (or is development required)?
 - Determine if other clients successfully using this change?
 - If the change will require development time, please answer the following of your vendor:
 - Is your vendor willing to make a change?
 - What is the expected level of effort?
 - Will the vendor charge the participant for the requested change?
 - How soon can a change be implemented? Will it require waiting for a product upgrade cycle?
- Any suggestions or objections to this approach may be discussed during the Q&A period

FDA Pilot Invitation

The eHealth Exchange is recruiting participants to exchange validation data (i.e., no-PHI) for a proof of concept (POC) with the FDA. The pandemic has highlighted the importance of FDA's regulatory mission to ensure the safety of vaccines in a post-authorization setting. The objective of this POC is to determine the ability of an exchange infrastructure to confirm that previously reported/identified vaccine adverse event cases (e.g., facial nerve palsy following immunization) meet clinical case definition criteria. Though this use case is consistent with established eHealth Exchange policy (i.e., DURSA), this POC will not involve production (PHI) servers and will not be used for regulatory purposes.



Hub Maintenance Window – Change Proposal

What?

- New Maintenance Schedule
- Improved Communication Process

- Separate VAL and PROD events
- Avoid nightly Federal HIE pre-fetch
- Improve ability to validate changes
- Move events requiring outage to low volume time
- Provide historical log of changes
- Provide post-maintenance status
- Reduce email fatigue

Content Validation Update

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Participant Status – Content Testing Update

Out of 279 Participants required to pass Content Testing by May 1, 2021:

- 16,823 documents tested as of May 18, 2021
- 86% or 240 Participants are @ Content Validated Status as of May 18, 2021
 - Increase from 153 in April 2021

Transition to FHIR R4

- Work on customizing HAPI for authentication/authorization is complete
- Work to standup the UDDI endpoint is ~90% complete
- A demo server has been configured in order to prepare for implementation
- Updates to the eHX R4 IG are being made as appropriate. For instance, the StatesofOperation field has been added to the IG
- In the process of completing mock-ups for the Directory self-service portal
- We are beginning our discussions around implementation of the HAPI R4 environment. More to come on this in future updates



OPEN SEASON!

- All Participants should have updated their trust stores to include the new CA trust bundles by 3/1. If your organization has not yet completed this step, please do so **ASAP! Failure to do so will cause connectivity issues with pilot organizations.**
- Your existing Entrust root/intermediate certs will need to remain installed as well. The new trust stores can be found here: https://desk.zoho.com/portal/directtrust/en/kb/articles/installing-sequoia-project-trust-chains
- Open season has begun and all organizations are now being pushed to the new process as their certs near expiration.
- Entrust certificates are being issued in emergency situations only!

What do I need to do?

- If your certificate expires in May/early June, your most recent Subscriber should have already received outreach with an introduction to DirectTrust.
- If you have not received that outreach and your certificate is nearing expiration, please send an e-mail to techsupport@sequoiaproject.org so that we can facilitate the intro as soon as possible.
- Please note that the new process will involve new Identity Proofing steps and certificate agreements.
 Your organization will be assigned a Certificate Authority vendor and will receive the appropriate forms once the CA vendor is assigned.
- All organizations that were issued Entrust certs in 2021 (Jan-early May) will be contacted around September of 2021 to transition to the new CA vendor certs.
- The transition off of all Entrust certificates is scheduled to be completed November 2021.

What does the new process look like?

 Once the introduction to DirectTrust is provided, they will respond requesting that you complete a new certificate spreadsheet.

What does the new process look like?

- After you've returned the spreadsheet, DirectTrust will assign you to one of two CA's:
 - MaxMD
 - EMRDirect
- Your organization does not get to request a specific CA, this is assigned by DirectTrust.
- DirectTrust will provide instructions for your Sponsor to complete Identity Verification through your assigned CA. Identity Proofing is not required for VAL certs.
- Once Identity Proofing is completed, a link will be provided for the Sponsor to retrieve the certificate.
