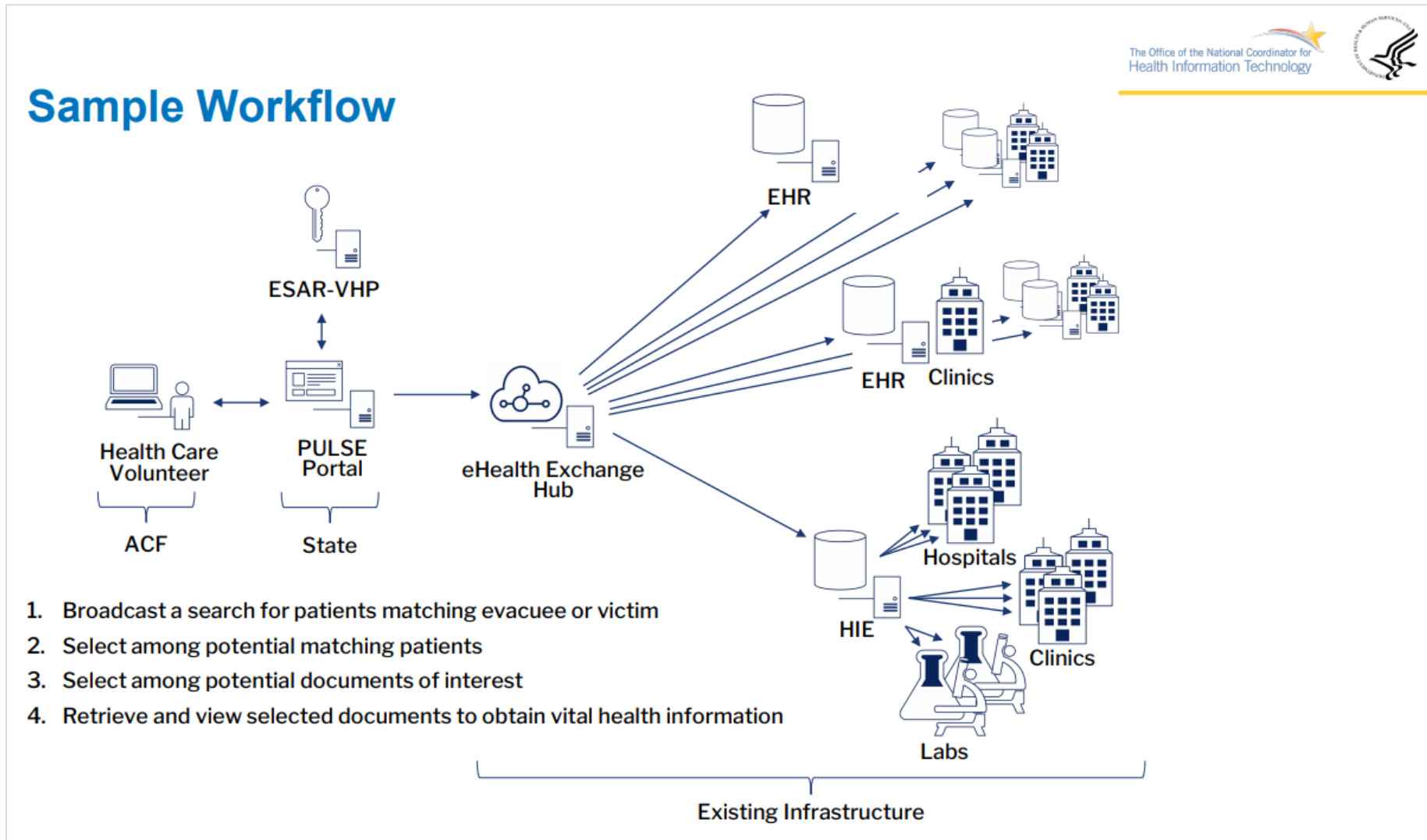

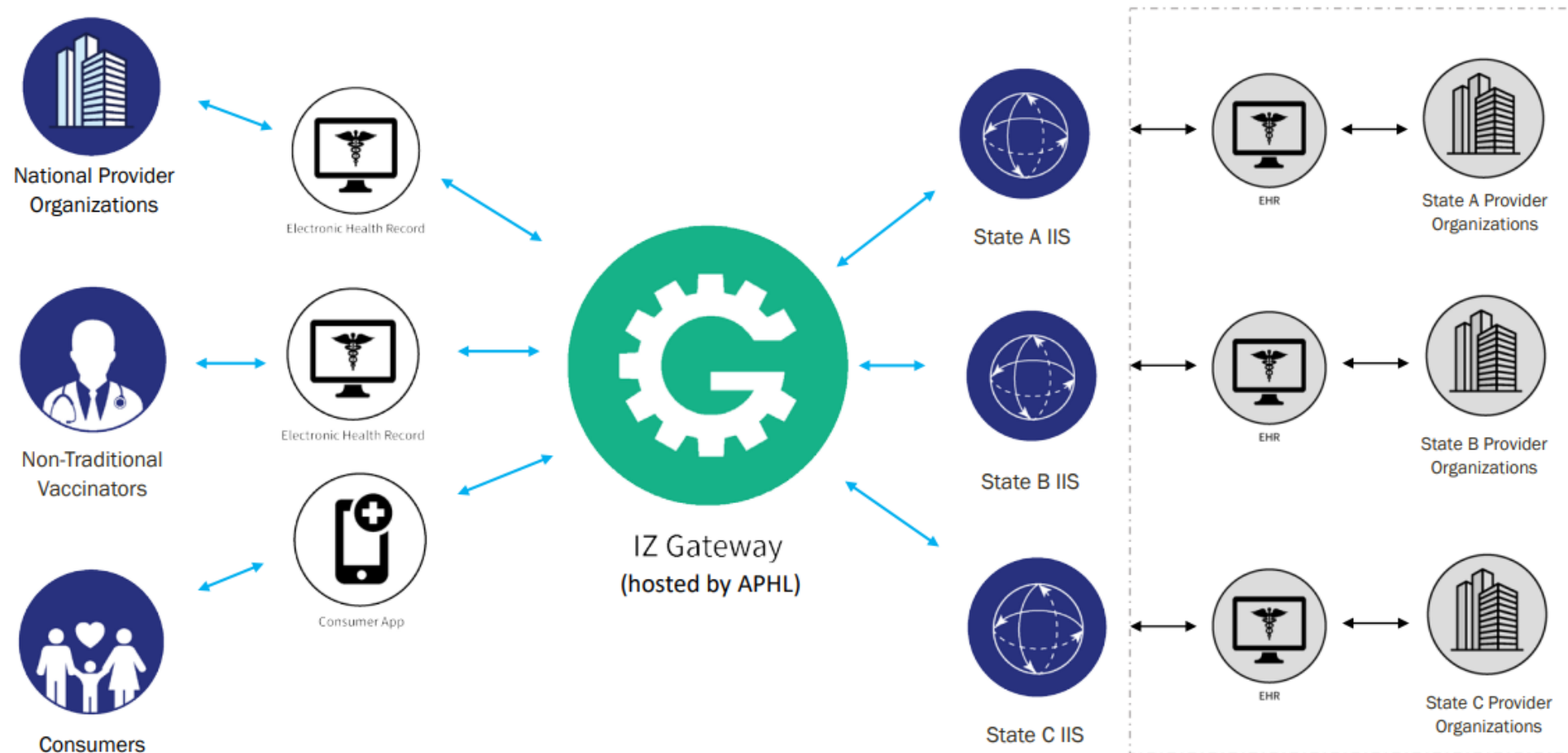

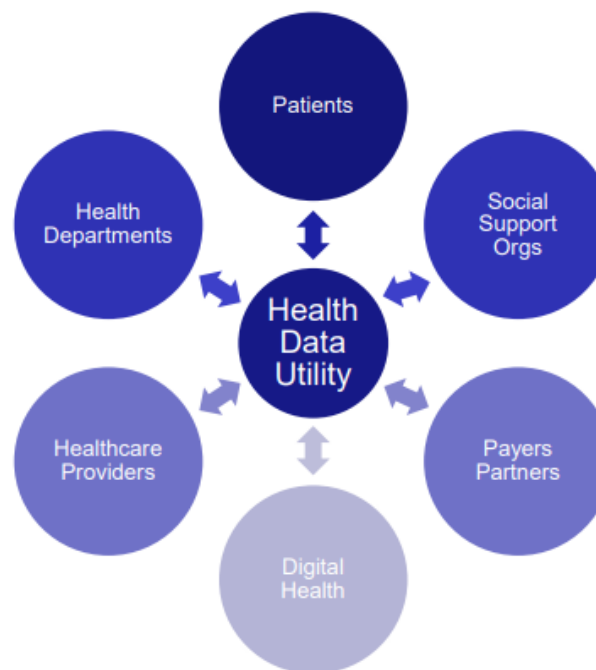
The **IZ Gateway** is a **centralized technical infrastructure** that supports bidirectional exchange of immunization data.



The IZ Gateway does not replace existing connections with state immunization information systems

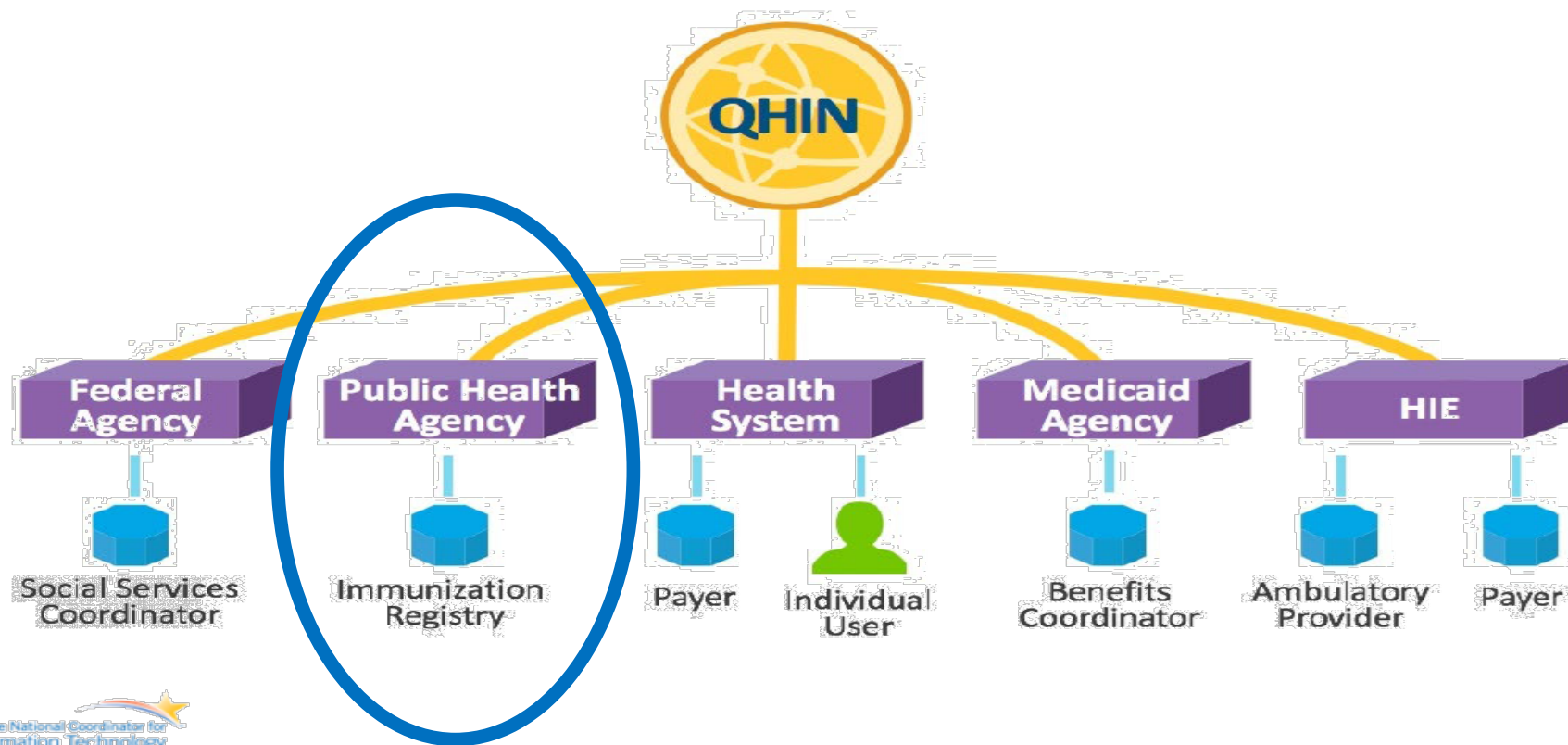
Why Health Data Is Good Infrastructure

- One of the lessons from Covid-19 is the gaping divide between public health and clinical care
- HIEs have evolved to meet those needs, serving as hubs for clinical data and increasingly sharing social service and claims data with provider, health plan and hospital partners



QHIN Example: Various Participants

In this example, the QHIN directly supports federal agencies, state agencies, health systems, and HIEs as Participants. The members of the federal/state agencies, health systems, and HIEs are Participant Members and Individual Users.
